
Bridge with Richard Ward

This hand was recently reported by renowned author Barry Rigal in the 2020 Gold Coast Congress Daily Bulletin.



The bidding was an uninterrupted 1C - 1S - 1NT - 4S to which West led the four of diamonds. With a potential loser in spades plus one each in the other suits, South resisted the temptation to automatically play the queen of diamonds at trick one. Instead she played low and East would have needed to be clairvoyant to insert the nine. He wasn't psychic so he didn't. After the diamond ace and a heart return, declarer was able to throw a heart loser on the diamond queen as it lost to the king and later, a club loser on the diamond jack. On a hand where many went down, declarer lost just two diamonds and a spade - successfully avoiding the need for a winning guess in trumps.
